

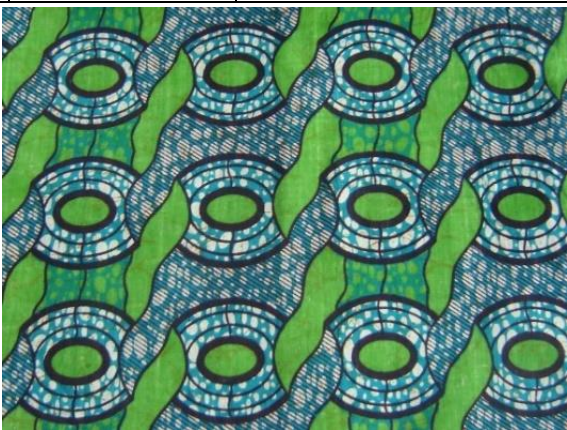
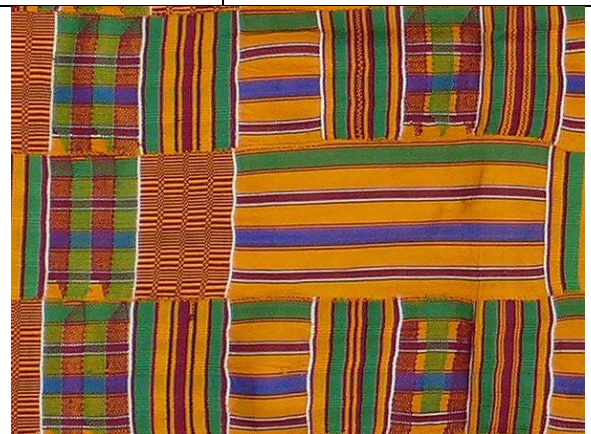


Key Vocabulary		Definition	Examples of African Masks
1	Batik	Batik is a traditional art-form which involves using wax and dye to create beautiful and intricate patterns on cloth	 
2	Wax Resist	Using a waxy medium to create a design; a wash of colour is layered over the design to create a desired effect.	
3	Positive Space	refers to the main focus of a picture	
4	Negative Space	negative space refers to the background	
5	Carving	To make something by cutting into a stone or wood.	
6	Weaving	the craft or action of forming fabric by interlacing threads	
7	Pattern	a design in which lines, shapes, forms or colours are repeated	
8	Relief	when three-dimensional elements are raised from a flat base.	
9	monochrome	A monochrome artwork uses only one colour	
10	Mixed Media	artworks composed from a combination of different media or materials.
