


DT Knowledge Organiser

Key Vocabulary		Definition	Examples
1.	Costume Designer	A person who designs costumes for a film, stage production or television show.	
2.	Investigate	To observe or study by close examination.	
3.	Sketching	Sketching is the quickest way of getting initial designs on paper before an idea is forgotten.	
4.	Compare	To examine (two or more objects, ideas, people, etc.) in order to note similarities and differences.	
5.	Modify	To make minor changes to something.	
6.	Manufacture	To make (something) on a large scale using machinery.	
7.	Plan	A detailed scheme or method for attaining an objective.	
8.	Tailor	A person whose occupation is the making, mending, or altering of clothes, especially suits, coats, and other outer garments.	
9.	Improve	To make or become better in quality.	
10.	Evaluate	To judge the quality, value or importance of something.
