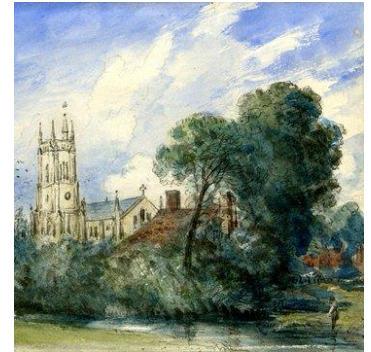


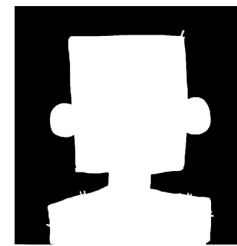
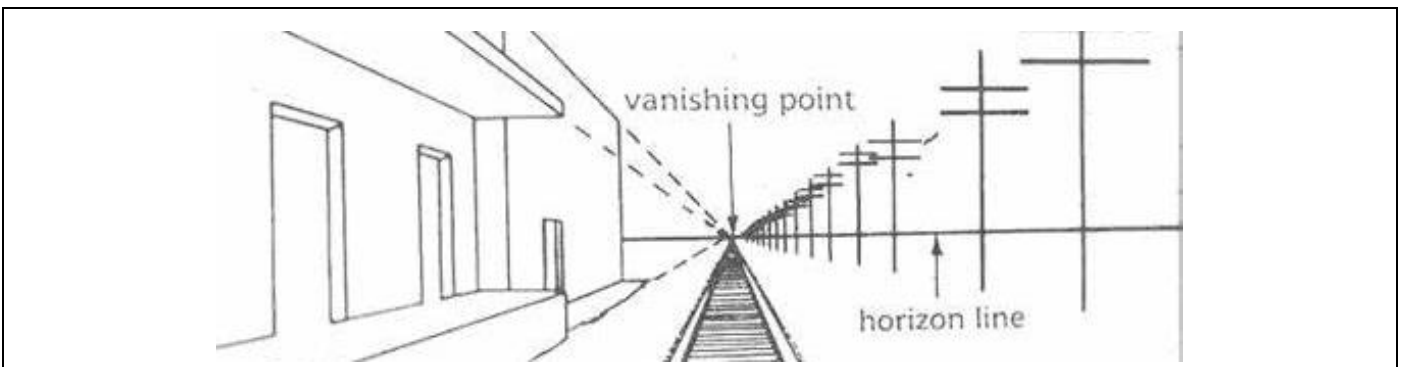
Art Knowledge Organiser

Key Vocabulary		Definition
1	Aesthetic	Relating to the study or enjoyment of beauty.
2	Interior/exterior	The inside of something / the outside of something
3	Façade	The facade of a building, especially a large one, is its front wall or the wall that faces the street.
4	Perspective	The way that objects appear smaller when they are further away and the way parallel lines appear to meet each other at a point in the distance
5	Vanishing Point	The point in a drawing or painting where parallel lines seem to meet at a distance
6	Trompe l'oeil	A French word meaning 'trick of the eye.' A painting that is cleverly designed to trick people into thinking that the objects represented in it are really there.
7	Symbolism	The use of symbols in art, literature, films, etc. to represent ideas
8	Atmosphere/ambience	The character, feeling, or mood of a place or situation
9	Positive Space	The area or part of an artwork's composition that the subject occupies e.g. a vase of flowers in a painting.
10	Negative Space	The empty space around and between the subject(s) of an image or sculpture
