



Key Vocabulary		Definition	Examples of Artwork
1	Magnify	To increase the size of something.	 <p>Louise Bourgeois – Spider, 1996.</p>  <p>Horoshi Shiino – Insects, 2011</p>
2	Complementary colours	pairs of colours that contrast with each other more than any other colour, and when placed side-by-side make each other look brighter.	
3	Shade	a mixture of a colour with black, which increases darkness.	
4	Tint	a mixture of a colour with white, which increases lightness.	
5	Tone	is produced either by mixing a colour with grey.	
6	Hue	A colour.	
7	Texture	How something feels when it is touched.	
8	Sculpture	The creation of artistic objects in three dimensions – length, width and height.	
9	Blend	To gradually and gently join two colour, tones or images together.	
10	Iridescent	the quality of showing many bright colours that change with movement
