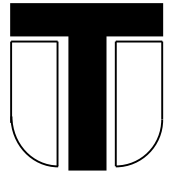


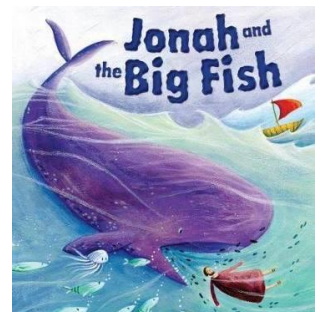
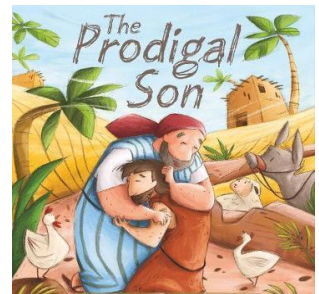
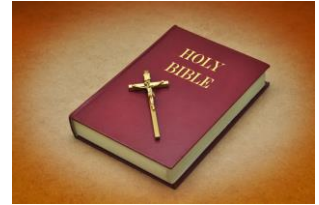
Religious Education Year 2/3 Autumn Term 1



What do Christians believe God is like?

Knowledge

- Christians believe that there is one god.
- Christians find out about their god by reading the Bible.
- The Bible teaches that God is loving, kind, forgiving and fair.
- Jesus told parables: simple stories which teach a lesson about what God is like and how God wants people to behave.
- The parable of the Lost Son (also known as the Prodigal Son) teaches that God is loving and forgiving, like a father.
- The story of Jonah teaches that God is everywhere, knows everything and listens to prayer.
- Christians have a relationship with God – the love goes both ways.
- Christians worship God and try to live in ways that please him.



Vocabulary

Bible = the Christian holy book which teaches about God

Christian = someone who practises the religion Christianity

forgiving = willing to move on and stop feeling angry or upset with someone when we feel that they have treated us unfairly

God = the Christian creator, Lord and King of all creation

relationship = a connection between two or more people

parable = a simple story, often told by Jesus, which teaches a lesson

prayer = talking to God, often to say thank you, sorry or please

worship = to show love and admiration to God
