Knowledge

- The Bible is the holy book of Christians; they use it to guide them.
- The Bible is split up into the Old Testament and the New Testament.
- The Old Testament tells stories from before Jesus was born.
- The New Testament tells stories about Jesus' life.
- The Bible teaches people to show kindness to everyone.
- The Bible teaches people to be courageous.
- The Bible teaches people to do what is right.
- Bible stories can guide both Christians and non-Christians.



Vocabulary

book = the Bible is split into smaller sections called books

courageous = brave/not put off by fear of danger or pain

faith = a strong belief in something (often belief in a religion)

holy book = a book that shares religious teachings/is used in worship

New Testament = the second part of the Bible about Jesus' life

Old Testament = the first part of the Bible, before Jesus was born

tax collector = someone who collects money to give to a ruler/leader

temptation = wanting to do something even though it is wrong

will power = being able to control yourself and not be tempted
