

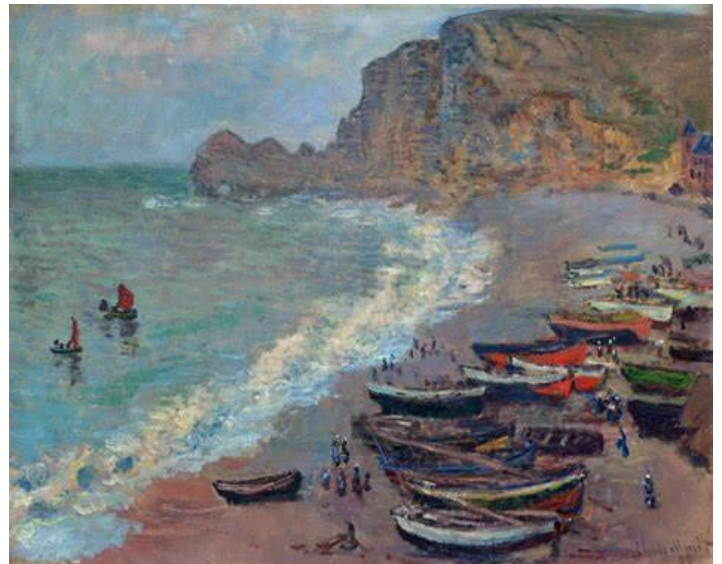


Art Knowledge Organiser

Key Vocabulary		Definition	Examples of Artwork
1	Texture	The way something feels when it is touched.	 <p>Clay is a natural material made up of tiny particles of rock. When clay is mixed with enough water, it feels like soft, gluey mud. Unlike plain mud, however, clay holds its shape. Clay can be pinched, rolled, cut or built up in layers to form shapes of all kinds.</p>
2	Tint	When a colour is made lighter by adding white to it.	
3	2d shape	2d shapes contain only 2 dimensions and are flat.	
4	3d shape	3d objects have 3 dimensions and are not flat. They take up space.	
5	mould	To use your hands to make a soft material (e.g clay) into a particular shape.	
6	sculpture	An art form made in 3 dimensions.	
7	pattern	A pattern is a design where shapes, colours or lines are repeated.	
8	tessellation	A pattern of 2d shapes which fit perfectly together, without any gaps.	
9	collage	The process of finding, collecting, arranging and sticking different materials.	
10	Collaboration	Working together to create something.
