Children have played with small balls of clay or stone since 4000BCE!
Glass marbles were created nearly 200 years ago.



The technique of **marbling** involves creating **patterns** on water using an **oil based ink**. Paper is then placed on top of the water and quickly absorbs the **colour** and **pattern**.



These much-loved adventures began as bedtime stories and letters for Kenneth Grahame's son, Alistair, inspired by **Grahame's childhood at Cookham Dene by the River Thames. (1908)**



Beatrix Potter was an English writer, illustrator and scientist. **She** is best known for her children's books featuring animals, such as The Tale of Peter Rabbit (1902)

1	Pattern	A repeating arrangement of numbers, colours and shapes.
2	Texture	How something feels when it is touched. (Rough, smooth, bumpy etc)
3	Illustrator	A person who draws or creates pictures for magazines, books, advertising.
4	Technique	A way of carrying out a particular task.
5	Collage	The creation of a work of art in which piece of paper, photos and/or fabric are arranged and stuck down onto a surface.
