3	collage	A picture that is made by sticking a mixture of different papers and cloths onto a single surface.
4	texture	The feel and appearance of a surface.
5	rough	Not a smooth or level surface.
6	prickly	A surface that has spikes
7	smooth	An even surface with no bumps etc.
8	hard	A solid, firm surface
9	mark making	The different marks we make when drawing, painting, sculpting etc.
