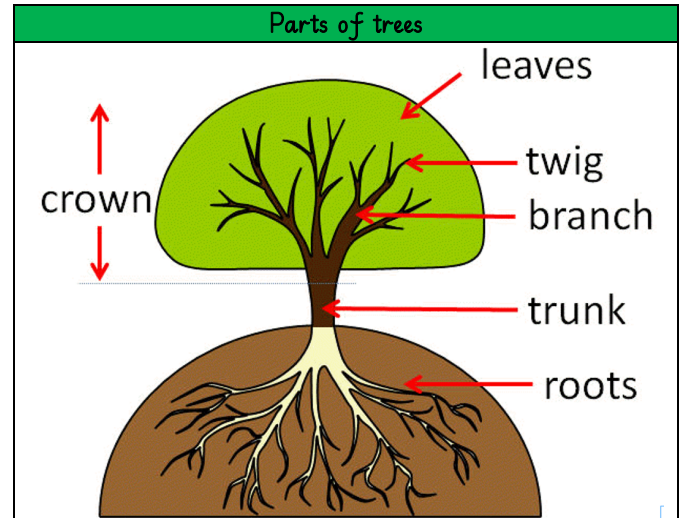


Key Knowledge	
What are the parts of flowering plants?	Flowering plants include: roots stem leaves flower fruit
What are the parts of trees?	Trees are made of: Roots Trunk Branches Leaves
What plants do we eat? What parts of plants do we eat?	We eat lots of different parts of plants: Apple – fruit Carrots – roots Lettuce – leaves Cinnamon – bark Rhubarb – stem Sunflower – seeds Broccoli – flower buds

Key Vocabulary	
Branches	Parts that grow out from the tree trunk and have leaves, flowers or fruit growing on them.
Bulb	An underground stem shaped like an onion that grows into a flower or plant.
Flower	The part of a plant which grows at the end of a stem and is often brightly coloured and smells nice.
Flowering	Trees or plants which produce flowers.
Fruit	Something which grows on a tree or bush and which contains seeds or a stone, often covered by a substance that you can eat.
Garden	A piece of land next to a house, with flowers, vegetables, other plants and often grass
Leaf / leaves	The parts of a tree or plant that are flat, thin and usually green
Petals	Thin coloured or white parts which form part of the flower.
Plant	A living thing that grows in the earth and has a stem, leaves and roots.
Roots	The parts of a plant that grow under the ground.
Seed	The small, hard part from which a new plant grows.
Stem	The thin, upright part of a plant on which the flowers and leaves grow.
Tree	A tall plant that has a hard trunk, branches and leaves.
Trunk	The large main stem of a tree from which the branches grow.
