Plant beans or seeds and bulbs.


Care for them and watch them grow.

Branches	Parts that grow out from the tree trunk and
	have leaves, flowers or fruit growing on them.
Bulb	An underground stem shaped like an onion that
	grows into a flower or plant.
Flower	The part of a plant which is often brightly
	coloured and grows at the end of a stem.
Flowering	Trees or plants which produce flowers.
Fruit	Something which grows on a tree or bush and
	which contains seeds or a stone, often covered
	by a substance that you can eat.
Garden	A piece of land next to a house, with flowers,
	vegetables, other plants and often grass
Leaf/	The parts of a tree or plant that are flat, thin
leaves	and usually green.
Petals	Thin coloured or white parts which form part
	of the flower.
Plant	A living thing that grows in the earth and has
	a stem, leaves and roots.
Roots	The parts of a plant that grow under the
	ground.
Seed	The small, hard part from which a new plant
_	grows.
Stem	The thin, upright part of a plant on which the
	flowers and leaves grow.
Tree	A tall plant that has a hard trunk, branches
	and leaves.
Trunk	The large main stem of a tree, from which the
\ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ \ \	branches grow.
Vegetation	Plants, trees and flowers.
Weed	An unwanted wild plant that grows in gardens
	and prevents the plants that you want from
	growing property.
Wild	Animals or plants that live or grow in natural
	surroundings and are not looked after by people.
