At Theale C of E Primary School we want staff and pupils to enjoy the sun safely. We will work with staff, pupils and parents to achieve this in various ways.

Education

- Children will be told during assembly how to be sun safe.
- Parents and guardians are informed in newsletters.

Protection

- The school playground has shade provided within the shelter and under trees.
- Children will be reminded to play in the shade during lunchtime play.
- Children will be encouraged to drink more water during hot weather.
- Children will be encouraged to wear sun hats when appropriate.
- When it is very hot and sunny, long outdoor sessions will be avoided.
- When it is very sunny at midday, pupils' exposure to the sun at any one time will be limited to 20 minutes.
- Parents and guardians will be encouraged to ensure that their children are protected by long lasting sunscreen each day before they arrive at school.
- Parents are asked to apply sunscreen in the morning that should last most of the day.
- Only small containers of sunscreen should be sent into school which the children can apply themselves. Roll on sunscreen is recommended.
- The use of sunscreen will be encouraged if the children are to spend any length of time outside on hot days i.e. on school trips, sports day.
