Basic principles

As we are a primary school we do not send our own pupils unaccompanied on work experience, however, we do often have secondary school pupils and college pupils come to Theale C of E Primary School to carry out work experience.

- When students carrying out work experience arrive they are covered by their own institution's work experience policy which we see a copy of before they start working with us.
- Prior to commencing their work experience they visit our school with their school/college tutor and we show them around the school and explain what will be expected of them whilst they are with us.

Review

The governing body reviews this policy every two years. The governors may, however, review the policy earlier than this, if the government introduces new regulations, or if the governing body receives recommendations on how the policy might be improved.
