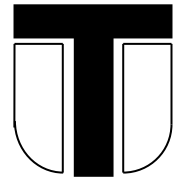


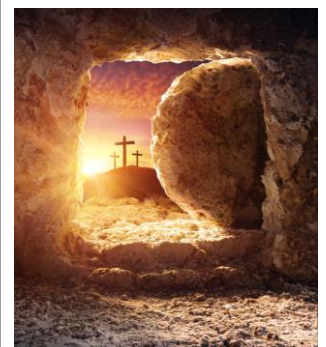

Knowledge

- Christians believe that Jesus' death is not the end of the Easter story.
- Christians believe that Jesus was resurrected at Easter, which is why it is celebrated by Christians.
- The Bible tells stories of Jesus appearing to his followers after his death and resurrection.
- Christians believe that Jesus' resurrection shows that they can also have life after death with God in heaven.
- Christians believe that Jesus was sent by God as a saviour. He was sent to save people from their wrongdoings so they can be close to God.



Vocabulary

**Christian** = someone who practises the religion of Christianity

**Easter** = a Christian festival celebrating the death and resurrection of Jesus so that people can be close to God

**God** = the Christian creator, Lord and King of all creation

**heaven** = often believed to be a place where God lives, where people can be with God after death

**Jesus** = God in the flesh (in human form), known as the son of God

**resurrection** = Jesus rising from the dead on Easter Sunday

**salvation** = being saved from wrongdoings so that people can be close to God

**Saviour** = Jesus, who saved people from sin so that they can be close to God
