
How important is it to Christians that Jesus came back to life after his crucifixion?




Knowledge

- Christians believe that Jesus' resurrection shows that they can also have life after death with God in heaven.
- Christians believe that Jesus was sent by God as a saviour. He was sent to save people from their wrongdoings so they can be close to God.







Vocabulary

Christian = someone who practises the religion of Christianity

Easter = a Christian festival celebrating the death and resurrection of Jesus so that people can be close to God

God = the Christian creator, Lord and King of all creation

heaven = often believed to be a place where God lives, where people can be with God after death

Jesus = God in the flesh (in human form), known as the son of God

resurrection = Jesus rising from the dead on Easter Sunday

salvation = being saved from wrongdoings so that people can be close to God

Saviour = Jesus, who saved people from sin so that they can be close to God
