UNCRC: The UN Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) is an important, legally binding agreement signed by 196 countries (as of 12 July 2022) which outlines the fundamental rights of every child, regardless of their race, religion or abilities

Rights: Things we are entitled to as individuals.

Responsibilities: Duties or obligations we have towards others.

Authority: People or institutions that have power or control.

Anti-social Behaviour: Actions that harm or lack consideration for others.

Wellbeing: A state of being comfortable, healthy, or happy.

Self-respect: Confidence in one's own worth or abilities.

Environment: The natural world around us.
