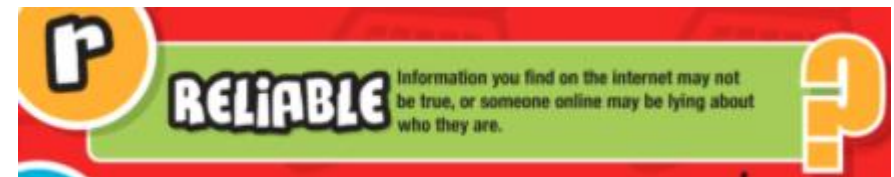
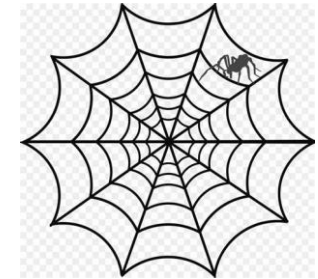
Key Learning:

- To recognise age restriction symbols on digital media and devices

Key Vocabulary:

- password – a secret word, phrase or combination of letters and numbers used to prevent unwanted access to a website or device
- website – a set of related web pages with a shared internet location
- internet – a global network of computers that all have the potential of accessing each other
- PEGI rating – an age-rating that shows which ages a game may be suitable for
